XIV A DISCIPLE OF CHRIST IS ONE WHO IS ***LIVING A LIFE OF SERVANTHOOD***

John 13:1-5 NKJV

- 1 Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.
- 2 And supper being ended, the devil having already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray Him,
- 3 Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God,
- 4 rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself.
- 5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

Philippians 2:5-8 NKJV

- 5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,
- 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
- 7 but made Himself of no reputation (emptied himself), taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
- 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.
