

Message: A Christlike mind has many unique and distinct characteristics, which we should pursue.

- I. A CHRISTLIKE MIND IS A *BELIEVING MIND* (Hebrews 11:6)

IV. A CHRISTLIKE MIND IS A HUMBLE MIND (Romans 12:3; 1 Peter 5:5-6; Phil 2:3; 6-8)

"It is a humility of mind toward the Lord and toward others"

Romans 12:3 (NKJV)

3 For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

1 Peter 5:5-6 (NKJV)

5 Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for

"God resists the proud,

But gives grace to the humble."

6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,

Phil 2:3,6-8 (NKJV)

- 3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.
- 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
- 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
- 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

IV. A CHRISTLIKE MIND IS A HUMBLE MIND (Romans 12:3; 1 Peter 5:5-6; Phil 2:3; 6-8)

"It is a humility of mind toward the Lord and toward others"

1. Humility of mind toward the Lord

- a. It is having a submissive attitude to the Lord (Rom 6:13; 12:1; James 4:7)
- b. It is having a servant mind (Phil 2:7)
- c. It is looking to the Lord (Hebrews 12:2)
- d. It is continually acknowledging and confessing your sins (1 John 1:9)
- e. It is giving the Lord the credit (James 1:17)

IV. A CHRISTLIKE MIND IS A HUMBLE MIND (Romans 12:3; 1 Peter 5:5-6; Phil 2:3; 6-8)

2. Humility of mind toward Others

- a. It is submitting to others (Ephesians 5:21)
- b. It is willing to be admonished and corrected (Colossians 3:16)
- c. It is serving others (Phil 2:7; John 13:14)
- d. It is lifting other up (Phil 2:3)
- e. It is confessing your wrongs to others (James 5:16)

IV. A CHRISTLIKE MIND IS A HUMBLE MIND (Romans 12:3; 1 Peter 5:5-6; Phil 2:3; 6-8)

CHOOSE TO HAVE A MINDSET OF HUMILITY

Colossians 3:12 (NKJV)

12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering;

Jesus died for your sins, for your wrongdoings.

Admit you are a sinner and that you are sorry for your sins.

Believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead to forgive your sins and give you salvation.

Confess Jesus as your personal Savior and Lord.
