18 Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,

Colossians 4:2 (NKJV)

1 Thessalonians 5:7 (NKJV)

7 For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk are drunk at night.

I. PRAYER IS A *CLEAR BIBLICAL COMMAND* (Isaiah 55:6; 1 Timothy 2:1; 1 Thessalonians 5:17)

Isaiah 55:6 (NKJV)

6 Seek the Lord while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near.

1 Timothy 2:1 (NKJV)

2 Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men,

1 Thessalonians 5:17 (NKJV)

17 pray without ceasing,

II. PRAYER IS HOW WE EXPERIENCE GOD'S PRESENCE

(Psalm 16:11; James 4:8; Acts 16:25-26)

Psalm 16:11 (NKJV)

11 You will show me the path of life;

In Your presence is fullness of joy;

At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

James 4:8 (NKJV)

8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Acts 16:25-26 (NKJV)

25 But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. 26 Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed.

III. PRAYER IS HOW WE RECEIVE FROM GOD

(Matthew 7:7; John 14:14; John 15:7)

Matthew 7:7 (NKJV)

7 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

John 14:14 (NKJV)

14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it

John 15:7 (NKJV)

7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

IV. PRAYER IS **BEING CHRISTLIKE**

(Mark 11:35; Luke 6:12)

Mark 1:35 (NKJV)

35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.

Luke 6:12 (NKJV)

12 Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.

IV. PRAYER IS *HOW WE GET THE LORD INVOLVED IN OUR LIVES* (Jeremiah 33:3; Psalm 34:4; Psalm 34:6)

Jeremiah 33:3 (NKJV)

3 'Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.'

Psalm 34:4(NKJV)

4 I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.

Psalm 34:6 (NKJV)

6 This poor man called, and the Lord heard him; he saved him out of all his troubles.
