ALL KINDS OF PRAYER! IV. REPENTING PRAYER

Psalm 32:5 (NKJV)

I acknowledged my sin to You,
And my iniquity I have not hidden.
I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin.

Psalm 51:1-4 (NKJV)

- Have mercy upon me, O God, According to Your lovingkindness; According to the multitude of Your tender mercies, Blot out my transgressions.
- Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, And cleanse me from my sin.
- For I acknowledge my transgressions, And my sin is always before me.
- 4 Against You, You only, have I sinned,
 And done this evil in Your sight—
 That You may be found just when You speak,
 And blameless when You judge.

IV. REPENTING PRAYER

Psalm 51:10 (NKJV)

10 Create in me a clean heart, O God,
And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Psalm 139:23-24 (NKJV)

- 23 Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties;
- 24 And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.

V. DEDICATION/SURRENDER PRAYER

Psalm 18:1-2 (NKJV)

- 1 I will love You, O Lord, my strength.
- The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

Psalm 119:15-16 (NKJV)

- 15 I will meditate on Your precepts, And contemplate Your ways.
- 16 I will delight myself in Your statutes; I will not forget Your word.

V. DEDICATION/SURRENDER PRAYER

Matthew 26:39 (NKJV)

39 He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."

John 17:19 (NKJV)
