- <sup>7</sup> "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.
- <sup>8</sup> For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

# POWERFUL PRAYING! James 5:16-18

## V. PRAY WITH PERSISTENCE

#### **Luke 18:1-8 (NKJV)**

- <sup>1</sup> Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,
- <sup>2</sup> saying: "There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man.
- <sup>3</sup> Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, 'Get justice for me from my adversary.'
- <sup>4</sup> And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, 'Though I do not fear God nor regard man,
- <sup>5</sup> yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.' "
- <sup>6</sup> Then the Lord said, "Hear what the unjust judge said.
- <sup>7</sup> And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them?
- <sup>8</sup>I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find [this] faith on the earth?"

# POWERFUL PRAYING!

#### Matthew 15:21-28 (NKJV)

- <sup>21</sup> Then Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon.
- <sup>22</sup> And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed."
- <sup>23</sup> But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us."
- <sup>24</sup> But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."
- <sup>25</sup> Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!"
- <sup>26</sup> But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs."
- <sup>27</sup> And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table."
- <sup>28</sup> Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, **great is your faith!** Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

# POWERFUL PRAYING!

#### **Genesis 32:24-30 (NKJV)**

- <sup>24</sup> Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.
- <sup>25</sup> Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him.
- <sup>26</sup> And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!"
- <sup>27</sup> So He said to him, "What is your name?" He said, "Jacob."
- <sup>28</sup> And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed."
- <sup>29</sup> Then Jacob asked, saying, "Tell *me* Your name, I pray." And He said, "Why *is* it *that* you ask about My name?" And He blessed him there.
- <sup>30</sup> So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: "For I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved."
