III. TO GROW SPIRITUALLY, WE MUST BE **PRAYING**

1 Thessalonians 5:17 (NKJV)

¹⁷ pray without ceasing,

Ephesians 6:18 (NKJV)

¹⁸ praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—

IV. TO GROW SPIRITUALLY, WE MUST GO REGULARLY AND FREQUENTLY TO CHURCH

1 Corinthians 11:20 (NKJV)

²⁰ Therefore when you come together in one place, it is not to eat the Lord's Supper.

Hebrews10:25 (NKJV)

²⁵ not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

V. TO GROW SPIRITUALLY, WE MUST VERBALLY WITNESS FOR CHRIST

Romans 1:16 (NKJV)

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

2 Corinthians 5:18 (NKJV)

¹⁸ Now all things *are* of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,

Romans 10:14 (NKJV)

¹⁴ How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?
