⁷ Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

James 1:22-26 (NKJV)

²² But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

- ²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror;
- ²⁴ for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.
- ²⁵ But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.
- ²⁶ If anyone among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's religion is useless.
