BROUGHT US A NEW COVENANT KING AND KINGDOM (Acts 2:30,31; 1 Corinthians 15:25)

Acts 2:30,31 (NKJV)

³⁰ Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne,
³¹ he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ...

1 Corinthians 15:25 (NKJV)

²⁵ For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet.

***CONFIRMS AND DECLARES THAT CHRIST'S
DEATH WAS A PERFECT SAVING WORK*** (Romans
4:25)

Romans 4:25 (NKJV)

²⁵ who was delivered up because of our offenses (**Sins**),
and was raised because of our justification (**Romans
5:9 - which happened at the cross**).

III. THE RESURRECTION AND ASCENSION OF CHRIST
***MEANS ALL CHRISTIAN BELIEVERS WILL BE SAVED
UNTIL THE VERY END*** (Romans 5:10; Hebrews 7:25)

Romans 5:10 (NKJV)

¹⁰ For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life (**Resurrected Life**).

Hebrews 7:25 (NKJV)

²⁵ Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost (**Very End**) those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession (**Intercessory Prayer**) for them.

IV. THE RESURRECTION AND ASCENSION OF CHRIST
***MEANS WE ARE EXPERIENCING THE Poured OUT
HOLY SPIRIT*** (Titus 3:5-6; John 7:38-39)

Titus 3:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵ not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, ⁶ whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

John 7:38-39 (NKJV)

³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” ³⁹ But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Acts 1:9-11 (NKJV)

⁹ Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. ¹⁰ And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, ¹¹ who also said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This *same* Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.”

Titus 2:13 (NKJV)

³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” ³⁹ But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 (NKJV)

¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.
