## IV. THE RESURRECTION AND ASCENSION OF CHRIST ***MEANS WE ARE EXPERIENCING THE Poured Out Holy Spirit*** (Titus 3:5-6; John 7:38-39)

### **Titus 3:5-6 (NKJV)**

<sup>5</sup> not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

### **John 7:38-39 (NKJV)**

<sup>38</sup> He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” <sup>39</sup> But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

### **Acts 1:9-11 (NKJV)**

<sup>9</sup> Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. <sup>10</sup> And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, <sup>11</sup> who also said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This *same* Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.”

## V. THE RESURRECTION AND ASCENSION OF CHRIST ***MEANS ASSURANCE OF THE SECOND COMING OF CHRIST*** (Acts 1:9-11; John 14:3; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17)

### **John 14:3 (NKJV)**

<sup>3</sup> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also.

### **1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 (NKJV)**

<sup>16</sup> For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. <sup>17</sup> Then we who are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.
