## I. The Lord Is Our Hiding Place In Time Of Trouble.

### **Psa. 32:7 (NKJVS)**

<sup>7</sup> You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of deliverance. Selah

### **Psa. 119:114 (NKJVS)**

<sup>114</sup> You are my hiding place and my shield; I hope in Your word.

### **Psa. 46:1 (NKJVS)**

<sup>1</sup> God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

## **II. In The Place Of Trial We Must Refuse To Fear**

### **Psa 46:2 -3 (NKJVS)**

<sup>2</sup> Therefore we will not fear, even though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; <sup>3</sup> Though its waters roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with its swelling.

### **Heb. 10:38a (NKJVS)**

<sup>38</sup> Now the just shall live by faith;...

### **Rom. 8:28 (NKJVS)**

<sup>28</sup> And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

### **2 Cor. 4:17 (NKJVS)**

<sup>17</sup> For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory,

<sup>7</sup> The LORD of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah

**Psa. 46:10 (NKJVS)**

<sup>10</sup> Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!

**Prov. 3:5-6 (NKJVS)**

<sup>6</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

## IV. In The Place Of Trial We Must Remain Unmovable, Trusting The Lord And Refusing To Entertain Anything Contrary To What He Has Shown Us.

### **Rom. 4:17 - 20 (NKJVS)**

<sup>17</sup> (as it is written, “I have made you a father of many nations”) in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did; <sup>18</sup> who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations, according to what was spoken, “So shall your descendants be.” <sup>19</sup> And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah’s womb. <sup>20</sup> He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God,

### **Psa. 19:14 (NKJVS)**

<sup>14</sup> Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my strength and my Redeemer.
