# II. A TOTALLY COMMITTED CHRISTIAN LIFE IS AN OBEDIENT LIFE (John 2:5; John 14:15; John 14:20)

#### John 2:5 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> His (Jesus) mother said to the servants, "Whatever He (Jesus) says to you, do it."

#### John 14:15 (NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> "If you love Me, keep My commandments.

#### John 14:21 (NKJV)

<sup>21</sup> He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

# III. A TOTALLY COMMITTED CHRISTIAN LIFE IS A GODLY SATURATED LIFE (Ephesians 3:19; 5:18-20; Philippians 1:11;

Colossians 3:16)

#### Ephesians 3:19 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup> to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

#### Ephesians 5:18-20 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, <sup>19</sup> speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, <sup>20</sup> giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

#### Philippians 1:11 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> being filled with the fruits of righteousness which *are* by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

#### Colossians 3:16 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

#### IV. A TOTALLY COMMITTED CHRISTIAN LIFE IS A HOLY

**LIFE** (Romans 12:2; TITUS 2:11 -12; 1 Peter 1:15-16)

#### Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

<sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

#### TITUS 2:11 -12; Peter 1:15-16(NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, <sup>12</sup> teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

#### Peter 1:15-16(NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> but as He who called you *is* holy, you also be holy in all *your* conduct, <sup>16</sup> because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."
