### **Isaiah 65:17 (NKJV)**

<sup>17</sup> “For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.

### **Revelation 21:1-3(NKJV)**

<sup>1</sup> Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. <sup>2</sup> Then I, <sup>[a]</sup>John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. <sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, “Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them *and be* their God.
