<sup>3</sup>that no one should be shaken by these **afflictions**; for you yourselves know that we are **appointed** to this. <sup>4</sup>For, in fact, we told you before when we were with you that we **would suffer tribulation**, just as it happened, and you know.

## 1 Peter 4:19 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup>Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls *to Him* in doing good, as to a faithful Creator.

# I. TRIALS COME INTO OUR LIVES TO *TEST US*

(James 1:3-4; Judges 3:1-4)

## **James 1:3-4 (NKJV)**

<sup>3</sup> knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. ⁴ But let patience have *its* perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

## Judges 3:1-4 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Now these *are* the nations which the Lord left, that He might test Israel by them, *that is,* all who had not known any of the wars in Canaan <sup>2</sup> (*this was* only so that the generations of the children of Israel might be taught to know war, at least those who had not formerly known it), <sup>3</sup> *namely,* five lords of the Philistines, all the Canaanites, the Sidonians, and the Hivites who dwelt in Mount Lebanon, from Mount Baal Hermon to the entrance of Hamath. <sup>4</sup> And they were *left, that He might* test Israel by them, to know whether they would obey the commandments of the Lord, which He had commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

# II. TRIALS COME INTO OUR LIVES TO *INWARDLY STRENGTHEN US* (Philippians 4:12-14)

### Philippians 4:12-14 (NKJV)

- <sup>12</sup> I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. <sup>13</sup> I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
- <sup>14</sup> Nevertheless you have done well that you shared in my *distress* (*tribulation*).

# III. TRIALS COME INTO OUR LIVES TO *DRAW US CLOSER TO THE LORD* (Psalm 34:4-6; Psalm 77:1-2)

### **Psalm 34:4-6 (NKJV)**

<sup>4</sup>I sought the Lord, and He heard me,

And delivered me from all my fears.

<sup>5</sup> They looked to Him and were radiant,

And their faces were not ashamed.

<sup>6</sup> This poor man cried out, and the Lord heard him,

And saved him out of all his troubles.

## **Psalm 77:1-2 (NKJV)**

<sup>1</sup> I cried out to God with my voice—

To God with my voice;

And He gave ear to me.

<sup>2</sup> In the day of my trouble I sought the Lord;

My hand was stretched out in the night without ceasing; My soul refused to be comforted.
