(2 Thessalonians 2:15; Ephesians 6: 11, 13, 14)

## 2 Thessalonians 2:15 (NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> Therefore, brethren, ***stand*** fast and hold the traditions which you were taught, whether by word or our epistle.

## Ephesians 6: 11, 13, 14 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to ***stand*** against the wiles of the devil.

<sup>13</sup> Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to ***stand***.

<sup>14</sup> ***Stand*** therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness,

## III. STAND AGAINST THE **NEGATIVE FORCE** **OF SIN** ( Romans 6:6; Romans 6:11-14 )

### Romans 6:6 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> knowing this, that our old man was crucified with *Him*, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.

### Romans 6:11-14 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

<sup>12</sup> Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. <sup>13</sup> And do not present your members *as* instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members *as* instruments of righteousness to God. <sup>14</sup> For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
