Message: In our pressing forward to spiritual maturity, we must <mark>press</mark> through different hindering obstacles.

(Philippians 3:14)

I. WE NEED TO **PRESS THROUGH DOUBT AND DISBELIEF** (Mark 9:24)

Mark 9:24 (NKJV)

²⁴ Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!"

II. WE NEED TO **PRESS THROUGH DISTRACTIONS** (Hebrews 12:2)

Hebrews 12:2 (NKJV)

² looking (looking away from something and focus) unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, ...

(Philippians 3:14)

III. WE NEED TO PRESS THROUGH DEVASTATING TRIALS AND CIRCUMSTANCES (Acts 14:22; James 1:2; James 1:12)

Acts 14:22 (NKJV)

²² strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting them to continue in the faith, and saying, "We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God."

James 1:2 (NKJV)

² My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,

James 1:12 (ESV)

¹² Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.

(Philippians 3:14)

IV. WE NEED TO **PRESS THROUGH DISCOURAGEMENTS** (Psalm 42:5-6; 1 Samuel 30:6)

Psalm 42:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵ Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him For the help of His countenance.

⁶ O my God, my soul is cast down within me;...

1 Samuel 30:6 (NKJV)

⁶ Now David was greatly distressed, for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. *But David strengthened (encouraged) himself in the Lord his God*.
