Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, **that you may prove (discern) what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.**

- I. TO KNOW GOD'S PERFECT WILL, WE MUST BE
SURRENDERED TO THE LORD AND HIS WILL

(Romans 6:13; Romans 12:1; Luke 22:42)

Romans 6:13; (NKJV)

¹³ ... *present (yield) yourselves to God*

Romans 12:1 (NKJV)

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you *present (yield) your bodies a living sacrifice*, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service.

Luke 22:42 (NKJV)

⁴² saying, "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

- II. TO KNOW GOD'S PERFECT WILL, WE MUST BE
SEEKING THE LORD AND HIS WILL (*Jeremiah 29:13;*
Matthew 6:33)

Jeremiah 29:13 (NKJV)

¹³ And you will seek Me and find *Me*, when you search for Me with all your heart.

Matthew 6:33 (NIV)

³³ But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

2 Corinthians 6:17-18

¹⁷ Therefore

“Come out from among them

And be separate, says the Lord.

Do not touch what is unclean,

And I will receive you.”

¹⁸ “I will be a Father to you,

And you shall be My sons and daughters,

Says the Lord Almighty.”

2 Corinthians 7:1 (NIV)

¹ Therefore, having these promises, beloved, ***let us cleanse ourselves from***

all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

¹⁵ but as He who called you *is* holy, you also ***be holy in all your conduct (everything you do),***

¹⁶ because it is written, "***Be holy, for I am holy.***"
